CUSTOMAXXX HAS AGAIN BROKEN THE MOLD OF BICYCLE DESIGN WITH THE LAUNCH OF THE DOMINATOR AND EEZEE.

Customaxxx made their entry into the cycling scene with their chopper-inspired Roar that's big in every sense of the word. From the low rider feel to the flaming aesthetics on its aluminium plated body, the Customaxxx's debut oozes pure rockstar wildness. Now with their new entries into their family of cool cruisers, they are looking to push the envelope again to what is considered orthodox and what is considered insane in bike building with the Dominator and the EeZee. Both these bikes sit on the exact opposite spectrum of cruiser-dom to each other and yet are equally radical in design.



THE DOMINATOR

The Dominator is a butcher of a cruiser with its brutal good looks that invites you to trash the living daylight out of it. The design started with a truss frame bolted together. You get those big fat 24"x100mm wheels as standard and chromed to perfection. The Ultra Beefy triple tree fork has its stanchions color coded to match the frame. The sitting posture and bike geometry were designed with fast downhill (on the road) in mind. The flat track handlebar just urges you to take that corner as low as possible till your guts give in. On a slow Sunday drive, you can still cruise at walking pace along the beach to take in the view.

THE EEZEE

The EeZee is a blackout chopper sharing the same frame with the limited edition Roar. This is probably the bike with the most attitude and stands its ground next to a custom motorcycle. Those over-the-hill ape hanger bar not only make a statement but is actually very ergonomically positioned. The totality of its sleek blackness gives the bike a subtle coolness that anyone can saddle it without looking out of place. Fat tires: checked. Ultra Beefy Fork: checked. Hydraulic brakes: checked. Now all you need is a long stretch of road heading towards the sunset, or you could always stop over at a coffee joint so you can park the bike outside for the world to see.
